- Trello Board Instructions:
 1. Copy the board so you can edit it
 2. Read through all the materials and think about the structure of your sprints.
 3. Add your schedule and any organisational information to your “Schedule + Instructions” card. **Make sure you share the judging criteria and pitching rules with everyone before they start working.**
 4. Edit each SPRINT card as follows:
 - a. Check the deliverables against your hack goals. Add/remove when needed
 - b. Upload resources supporting participants to complete each task
 - c. Add any sponsor’s information in the card description (you can have a sponsor for each sprint)
- Pitch - we recommend to be VERY strict with the timing (you don’t want to go over 1 hour in total - people will not remember anything). Here it the format we use:
